## Avox upgrades www.wiki-data.com

Avox Limited, the leading provider of premium quality, low latency business entity data and services, today announced that it has rolled out a significant set of upgrades to its free online company look up service, [www.wiki-data.com](http://www.wiki-data.com).

### Additional Entities

Avox currently publishes a subset of the total number of entities it holds in its central database onto wiki-data. Two new classes of records have been added as of June 21. Specifically 37,962 government entities and municipalities and 6,145 "sub-legal entities" or branches have been added bringing the total number of entities published on wiki-data to over 320,000. These entities are all watch listed for existing Avox clients. By publishing the basic information about these entities for free on the internet, Avox is able to gather a much broader volume of feedback from a truly global user base.

### Now Updated Daily

As of June 21, changes and additions to wiki-data will be applied on a daily basis instead of the weekly frequency previously available. This reduction in latency is imperative for our clients and prospects who are using wiki-data for client checks in their on-boarding processes as well as for data remediation teams serving compliance and risk functions.

Updates to the wiki-data content will be made each night from Monday to Thursday. A complete refresh will then be implemented on Saturday to ensure all updates have been captured.

"wiki-data is becoming increasingly popular with our clients who use it regularly to check for availability of data records and as a mechanism to easily request creation of new records." stated Ken Price, CEO of Avox. "Because the code and API are open source, clients can embed the functionality in their own front ends and participate directly in enhancing the functionality."

### **About wiki-data:**

Wiki-data is a free company look up service operated by Avox Limited. Users can collaborate via the front end or open API by challenging specific information, requesting more information, new records and enhanced functionality. Records are linkable via the AVID which is a URI (Uniform Resource Identifier). The AVID is itself linked to many other data identification standards.

Avox, a majority owned subsidiary of Deutsche Börse Group, manages a shared pool of business entity data for which updates are regularly contributed to by an international client base. Every data record and every proposed change is manually checked against up-to-date content from other authoritative sources including regulators, business registries and company filings. Data processed by Avox includes corporate hierarchies, addresses, industry codes, identifiers, regulatory content and links to issued securities.
